Recently there has been a lot of media attention on Netflix's Squid game. The show has a 15 rating but this has not prevented clips and images from the show being spread across various platforms such as YouTube and TikTok. There have been reports of children viewing gory, explicit scenes from the programme and parents need to be mindful of the prevelance of these uploads. What can parents do? Activate parental controls on their devices and check age restricted child profiles are set up on on demand platforms. If you see or hear your child replicating any of the challenges from the show or hear them talking about scenes and characters it is important to discuss with them that the show is not for children and the clips can be very upsetting.
