



Strike Action: As you may be aware from the media, the National Education Union (NEU), in accordance with the provisions of the Trade Union and Labour Relations Act 1992, are calling upon their members to strike. Some strike days will be regional, and others will be national. The proposed industrial action dates for the North West, and impacting on our school, are: Wednesday 1st

and Tuesday 28th February, and Wednesday 15th and Thursday 16th March 2023. We will endeavour to keep the school open wherever possible, however, we are writing to give you advance notice of this potential outcome so that you have time to plan childcare for your children. Over the coming days we will review guidance from the Trust, and DFE and will inform you about how the action will affect us closer to Wednesday 1st February when we are given an indication of which teachers may be taking part in the strike action.
