Important messages

COVID Update: We sent out a letter yesterday to update parents on our COVID protocols. We have seen an increase in cases over the last 10 days and want to make sure we keep children and staff as safe as possible. We have decided to postpone assemblies at the moment and will contact parents of any children we believe have been close contacts of positive cases. The national figures are coming down and the new variant seems to be less severe, however, we need to stay vigilant. Uniform reminders: As a team we have spoken about the importance of uniform and our appearance policy and we believe they are the foundations on which we build our school values and standards. The policy also helps to ensure that children are safe undertaking activities such as PE.

<u>https://northbrookpa.org/parents-carers/school-uniform</u>. A few key points we would like to remind parents about, are as follows:

- Jogging bottoms/tracksuit/sports leggings need to be plain black.
- Trainers/pumps are only suitable footwear for PE days.
- PE hoodies are to be worn on PE days only.
- We would prefer children not to wear earrings, but if they do they must be no more than one stud (not hoops or hooks) in each ear lobe.
- Children are not allowed to wear any jewellery during PE/Forest School/Swimming lessons for Health and Safety reasons. Children must either not wear earrings on these days, be able to remove earrings themselves or cover their studs with plasters (brought from home).
- <u>No jewellery should be worn for PE.</u>
- Nail polish, make up and temporary tattoos are not acceptable as part of the school uniform.
- Children with hair longer than shoulder length must have their hair tied back with a suitable hair accessory, to not restrict vision, so that they can safely enjoy all activities at school.
- Hair accessories should be discreet and in line with the colours of our school uniform. Large bows and novelty hair accessories must not be worn.
