How does Lancashire Talking address issues in my area? The

information gathered from participation in Lancashire Talking will help's the police improve the area where you live, identify vulnerabilities and help others. This is also an opportunity for you to make a difference in your own communities. By actively letting the police know what your concerns are, we and our partners can actively help you to make a change where you live. At the touch of a button our officers can use the data collected on a daily basis to pinpoint exactly what and where the issues are – whether that be a street, a school, a shop, or a park – and address those issues along with the council and our other partner agencies.

How can I keep updated with action taken via Lancashire Taking?

When you take part in the survey, you'll be asked if you'd like to become a member of 'In The Know', our community messaging system. Members of 'In The Know' will then receive updates directly into their inbox from their Neighbourhood Policing Team about the action taken based on the feedback we receive. To register for 'In The Know' you can collect a sip from the office in school. We will then hand to our PCSO for you to be registered. Thank you!
