

**Uniform and Appearance** - We would like to remind everyone of our expectations related to uniform and the key information can be found on our website <a href="here">here</a>. A key feature of our policy is what we wear (uniform) and how we wear it (appearance). In summary, some key points of note are:

- NORTHBROOK
- Grey skirt/pinafore, trousers. In summer grey tailored shorts or purple and white gingham dress.
- Leather style and sturdy school shoes for non-PE days *trainers and ballet style pumps* are not permitted.
- Full PE kit required for PE days (NPA hoodie & t-shirt, plain black shorts, plain black jogging bottoms and trainers)
- Plain black jogging bottoms (on PE days).
- Hair colour should be natural with no severe cuts or styles.

We will be rigorously enforcing our uniform and appearance policy after the holidays. Holiday Activities and Food Scheme: South Ribble Borough Council offer a programme of activities as part of the HAF scheme. The Holiday Activities and Food (HAF) scheme aims to provide healthy food and enriching activities for children aged 4 to 16 who are eligible for benefit-related Free School Meals. The fun activities on offer at their South Ribble Leisure Centres often include swimming, gymnastics, tennis and gym sessions. This provision as FREE of charge, offers fun activities and experiences and includes free food and refreshments.

- Please ensure your child is a suitable age for the activity before booking

Note: Unless stated otherwise activities are fully supervised and parents/guardians do not need to stay for the duration of the camp.
