

https://www.britishlegion.org.uk/get-involved/poppy-appeal . We recommend there is a minimum




donation of 20p per poppy and Year 6 Prefects will bring the collection box round classes each morning. The other items have the following donations:

Anti-Bullying Week Monday 14th – Friday 18th November:



Thank you to all the parents that completed the Parent View Questionnaire in October. We are so pleased with the feedback and your comments. We were particularly impressed with the following


