#### **Important messages**

Year 6 SATs: Our Year 6 children will be taking their Key Stage 2 SATs next week from Monday 9th May.

Although these assessments are important, we have been approaching them in balanced and supportive way to ensure our children have the understanding and knowledge to tackle the papers but also the resilience to deal with any stress or anxiety they may cause. During the year we have very much encouraged the children to simply 'try their very best' and to be determined in their approach even if they find some aspects of the tests difficult. We talk openly and honestly about why these tests are important but they do not totally encapsulate their learning during their time at Northbrook

Primary Academy or them as individuals. Next week we will be offering breakfast to all our Year 6 children in our dining room from 8:30am. We will offer sausage butties (meat free option too), cereals, toast and juice. This will help us ensure all children are in school early, 'fuelled' for the morning and allow us to collectively ease any fears as well as foster the team ethos we have worked so hard to establish at Northbrook. Children should enter school through the Before-School Club entrance. As a staff we will be doing everything we can to support each and every child and it goes without saying that we wish them all the very best of luck!
