Important messages



We introduced a new, intuitive and easy to use online appointment booking and video conferencing system for our Parents' Evening on Tuesday 6th July. This allowed us to see parents and children in a safe manner. The system worked well with only a couple of sound issues to report as negatives. For those of you that attended your appointment through the School Cloud system, we would like to thank you for your support! If you missed the appointment or had any technical issues, your child's class teacher will have attempted to call you by phone and left a message if they could not

get through. Please contact school if you have received a message so your child's teacher gets the opportunity to speak to you directly before we break for the summer!



Thank you to those of you that complete the parental questionnaire sent out after parents' evening. The feedback was useful and very positive. Some of the highlights include:

91% of parents 'Strongly Agree or Agree' their child is happy at NPA. 95% of parents 'Strongly Agree or Agree' their child feels safe at NPA. 90% of parents 'Strongly Agree or Agree' that at NPA deals with issues raised.

90% of parents **'Strongly Agree or Agree'** that NPA gives the **support** to their child that they need.

93% of parents 'Strongly Agree or Agree' that their child does well at NPA.

90% of parents 'Strongly Agree or Agree' that NPA keeps them informed about how their child is doing.



The feedback also made us aware that you would like to have clearer information on what your child is learning, more understanding of what we cover within or PSHE programme and to see us implement an increased extra-curricular offer, something that has undoubtedly been impacted by COVID this year. We will be working on this for next academic year. Please remember if something is troubling your child or you, as a parent, please do not hesitate to contact us at school.
