

Dear Parent/Carers.

We are very excited to be taking part in an 'Anglo Saxon' themed enrichment day at Woodlea Junior School on Tuesday 20th May. This will be the culmination of our wider curriculum work on 'The Anglo Saxons'. The children from Northbrook will walk to Woodlea and spend the day with their year 4s, enriching and embedding their history curriculum taught during the term.

There will be opportunities to create and taste Anglo-Saxon food, learn an Anglo-Saxon dance, use Anglo-Saxon writing techniques to make runes and create Anglo-Saxon jewellery.
