Anti-Bullying Week & Children in Need - Monday 11th - Friday 15th November

During the week of Monday 11th November – Friday 15th November we will be supporting Anti-Bullying Week and on Friday 15th November, Children in Need.

The theme of this years 'Anti- Bullying Week' is 'Respect' and during the week we will be taking part in a number of activities that will help us understand what it means to be respectful and how we can show respect to others.
