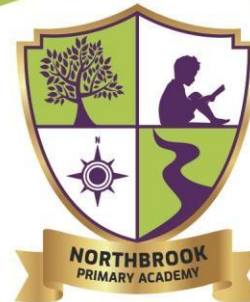


Northbrook Primary Academy - Homework

Can you research some facts about Leyland and present them in a poster? Can you draw and label some images that are related to Christianity and say why they are so important to them?</p>
