Then write a book review including how many stars you give it, who the main characters are, what the main events are and why it is your favourite story to read.
Paint a story In English this term we will be looking at traditional stories. Can you use paint to create your own story? Number hunt In Math's we are looking at addition and subtraction, can you find different numbers around the house and add and subtract them?	Characters Can you create a model of your favourite character from one of the traditional fairytales we have read? Answer the question Why was Florence Nightingale influential?
