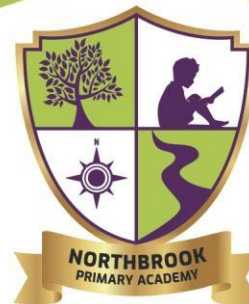

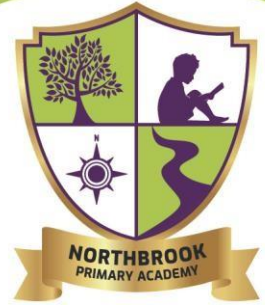
Half-term: Spring 1 (Monday 13th January – Monday 10th February)
