Key Stage 2 SATs Arrangements

I am sending this letter out to inform you about upcoming SATs arrangements, provide a little bit of background in to SATs week and offer you an invitation to attend a parent meeting.

Firstly, thank you for your continued support in getting your child ready for their end of year SATs. I know this is not an easy time but your support in preparing them and keeping them as calm as possible during this time is appreciated.

As you are aware, all Year 6 pupils will be taking their Key Stage 2 SATs from **Monday 13th May to Thursday 16th May.**

Tests will take place in the main hall and children will be provided with all the equipment they need. They do not need to bring pencil cases and water will be given to them at their desks.

During the WEEK OF SATs and also on the TUESDAY AND WEDNESDAY OF MOCK WEEK, we will be offering a FREE breakfast to all our Year 6 children in our dining room from 8:30am, therefore we would like children to be in school by 8.45 am at the latest. We will offer sausage butties (meat free option too), cereals, bagels and juice. This will help us ensure all children are in school early, 'fuelled' for the morning and allow us to collectively ease any fears as well as foster the team ethos we have worked so hard to establish at Northbrook. Children should enter school through the front entrance and make their way to the dining hall.

What are SATs?

Key Stage 2 SATs formally test your child's maths and English abilities with multiple papers. The week consists of one English reading paper, three mathematics papers and two English spelling, grammar and punctuation papers.

The test timetable for the week is as follows:

Monday 13th May Spelling, grammar and punctuation papers


Tuesday 14th May English reading paper

Wednesday 15th May Maths papers (Arithmetic and reasoning one)

Thursday 16th May Maths reasoning two

Year 6 mock week

Year 6 will be taking part in a mock SATs week during the first week back after the Easter break from Monday 15th of April until Thursday 18th April. This will mirror the actual week as best we can.
