Dear Parents,

Northbrook Primary Academy School Report 2020-21 - Years 1 to 6

We are pleased to attach your child's school report for the academic year. Please review the report with your child and identify the many positives contained within the report. We are very proud of our school community and the way in which they have demonstrated true Northbrook Primary Academy values, through what has been a challenging year due to the disruption we have all faced during the pandemic.

Within this letter we have included some key information that help you to fully understand the report and prepare for our **Parents' Evening on Tuesday 6th July**.

Your child as a Northbrook learner:

In the first section of the report, your child's class teacher has written an overview of their strengths, areas for development and their general attitude to learning over the year. This includes an overall judgement on their attitude to learning across the curriculum.

Mathematics and English:

The class teacher has written a summary of your child's progress and achievement within each of these core subjects, as well as issuing a clear target in preparation for the next academic year. They have also made a judgement on your child's current position and whether this *working towards greater depth* or above the expectations for the year group, *working within the expectations* for the year group or *working towards* these expectations.

Wider Curriculum subjects:

Your child's teacher has written succinct comments on each of the curriculum areas studied and graded your child's attitude to learning within each.

Attitude to Learning:

Reflects the 'big picture' including behaviour, attitude to classwork and homework and motivation.

1. **Excellent** – A highly motivated student with an outstanding attitude to learning. They consistently display resilience, commitment and an appropriate level of independence.
2. **Positive** - A committed student who has a positive attitude to learning. They regularly display resilience, commitment and an appropriate level of independence.
3. **Satisfactory** – A student who generally has a positive attitude to learning. Occasionally they may be off task, engage in low level distractions or are slow to engage with work.

Parents' Evening on Tuesday 6th July:

Parents' Evening will give you and your child the opportunity to listen to feedback from their teacher and to ask questions to support the preparation for next academic year. Unfortunately, due to the current COVID-19 situation and the increase in cases within the locality Parents Evening will no longer be a 'face to face' event. We will now host a virtual parents evening supported by 'School Cloud'. This will allow the event to run in a completely safe manner through video links

We will be sending you your log-in details and further information in an additional letter very shortly.
