NPA Summer Fair 2022 – Friday 1st July

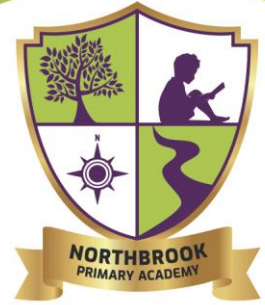
