We are excited to again be celebrating **National Poetry Day** around at Northbrook this year. National Poetry Day is an annual, national celebration that encourages everyone to create, experience and share poetry with family and friends and will be held on Thursday 5th October. This year's theme is 'Refuge' and children will be exploring poetry based on this theme.

To mark this special day, children at Northbrook Primary Academy are invited to take part in a poetry competition based around the national theme of "Refuge". To enter the competition children should write or print their poem and bring this to their class teacher.
