Dear Parents/Carers,

We are looking forward to welcoming you and your child into the Northbrook family in September 2024.

On **Wednesday 12th June**, we are thrilled to invite you and your child to an Induction Meeting at Northbrook. We will be offering two sessions, either at 1.30pm or 4.00pm. This meeting will give you the chance to learn all about your child's transition into school and give your child the opportunity to spend time in their new classroom with their Reception teacher, whilst we share lots of information with you and complete the enrolment paperwork. For this meeting, you will need to <u>bring your child's birth certificate</u>. Please indicate on the reply slip which of the time slots you and your child will be attending.

We are having 3 Transition Sessions in school this year; **Tuesday 2**nd **July, Monday 8**th **July and 17**th **July**. During this hour, your child will meet their new friends and explore their classroom. It is a great opportunity to get to know their teachers and for their teachers to get to know them. Parents will be able to remain in school and have a drink with other parents, whilst their child attends the transition visits but don't feel like you have to.


As part of the transition process, we will attend your child's nursery. This enables us to meet your child in a setting they are comfortable in and get information from the nursery teachers. We may also offer a Home Visit.

Our 'Stay and Play' sessions are starting on **Monday 20th May from 1.45pm till 3pm**. We would love if you could attend these sessions but also understand if you have other commitments. This is a great opportunity for your child to meet their new friends and for you to meet other parents as well as key staff within the school. An adult is required to attend with each child at these sessions. The sessions will be weekly until Monday 1st July. We will be having a Forest School Session on Monday 1st July. We are closed Monday 27th May for half term.
