### Sports Day – Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> July

This year's Sports Day will take place on Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> July. Unfortunately, as you are aware due to COVID-19 restrictions, parents and guardians are not permitted to attend but plenty of photos and videos will be uploaded via Seesaw and the school's social media accounts to celebrate the event.

We will keep the main events in the morning so that the field is cooler if we get a hot day. All year groups will begin at 9:30, it is vital that your child arrives to school on time to ensure they have time to be placed into the right group and play a full part in this whole school event.

Each year group will be split into their colour house teams and will compete in 12 different sporting activities, which will include the egg and spoon race, javelin throw, hockey dribble and speed bounce. Sports leaders from Wellfield High School will be leading each activity, supported by Northbrook Academy staff. We will ensure equipment is properly cleaned before the next year group 'bubble' arrive at the station to each station. There will be a 10-15minute rest period after 6 activities to allow the children to recover and hydrate.

In the afternoon, there will be a socially distanced awards ceremony, where the winning House Captains will be presented with the trophy and each member of the house team will receive their medal. There will certificates for all competitors.

We should be grateful if all children could arrive at school in their PE kit (*white t-shirt, black shorts, trainers, and school sweatshirt. The children may also wear tracksuit bottoms/joggers if they wish*) as they have been doing for PE lessons.

**IMPORTANT: Please will every child bring a plastic bottle of water.**

**Will you please make sure that your child(ren):**

- Brings a sunhat/cap
- Applies sun cream before leaving for school
- Wears suitable footwear/trainers
- Wears their correct school PE kit
- Takes their medication for hay-fever as, appropriate, before leaving for school

The lunch arrangements will run as normal, but the children may want to bring an additional snack for the morning session. School will finish at the regular time.

We will hold assemblies on Monday and Tuesday to ensure that all the children know how the event will run and that they understand our expectations for the day.



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We hope that the day will be a celebration of what it means to be part of our community, with each and every child demonstrating not only their sporting attributes but also the Northbrook Primary Academy values that lie at the heart of all that we do. Children may be removed from some or all of the activities if they do not behave as we would expect.
