Dear parents,

Northbrook Primary Academy Sports Day – Tuesday 5th July

This year's Sports Day take place on Tuesday 5th July and we are delighted to be able to invite parents to the final races and medal ceremony. We will also upload photos and videos via Seesaw of the morning activities as the children move round a variety stations challenging their athletic ability and teamworking skills.

All classes will begin at 9:30, it is vital that your child arrives to school on time to ensure they have time to be placed into the right group and play a full part in this whole school event.

Each class will be split into their colour house teams and will compete in 14 different sporting activities, which will include the egg and spoon race, javelin throw, hockey dribble and speed bounce. Sports leaders from Wellfield High School will be leading each activity, supported by Northbrook Academy staff. There will be a 10-15minute rest period after 7 activities to allow the children to recover and hydrate.

In the afternoon, we are extending the invite to a parent to watch the flat races and the medal ceremony, where the winning runners and house team will receive their medals and the House Captains will be presented with the sports day trophy. Please arrive at school at 1:00pm and enter through the Hague Avenue car park gates if travelling by car or the KS1 gate if walking to school. This car park can also be used for parking if required. During the races parents will be seated on the opposite side of the track from the children and children will not be allowed to leave their competitors area to go over and see parents. This is so we know where all our children are during the event. At the end of the event we will take the children back into school and collection at 3:10/3:15pm will be from the normal doors.

We would be grateful if all children could arrive at school in their PE kit (purple round neck t-shirt, black shorts, trainers and school hoody. The children may also wear tracksuit bottoms/joggers if they wish, as they do for PE lessons.

IMPORTANT: Please will every child bring a plastic bottle of water.


Will you please make sure that your child(ren):
