Next Tuesday, 14th October, we will be participating in a Stone Age Experience over at Woodlea, as part of our Wider Curriculum 'Stone Age unit of work'.

We will be walking over to Woodlea once the register has been taken and will be back before the end of the day. If your child has a school dinner, packed lunches will be provided. For those that bring sandwiches, please do so as normal.
