



### Communication and Language


We will use Colourful Semantics to support vocabulary development and application. Symbols are used across the curriculum to support learning and interactions. We will be learning Spanish through cultural experiences for a full morning once a half term. We will have lots of fun in our Attention Autism sessions which will support attention, communication and social skills.



### Maths

Alongside our peers we will be using White Rose Maths, Spring brings us work on place value, number, length and height, mass and volume.

Some of our children will be working on their times tables through TTRs.



### Understanding the World

In Science we will be looking at light and dark. Identifying light sources, why we need light and how shadows are made.

History covers transport over time, naming and grouping.

Comparing today's transport with vehicles from history. We will also be taking part in a trip to Martin Mere wetlands and taking our learning outside the classroom as much as possible.



### Literacy

We will continue to develop our phonic and spelling skills through our daily Read Write Inc. sessions. The children will read daily in class with an adult, reading at home is strongly encouraged to consolidate and develop vocabulary and fluency.



### Expressive Arts

This includes all Art, Music and Drama sessions.

We will be learning about the artist Claude Monet, looking at colour and landscapes, creating our own outdoor images.



We use the children's EHCP outcomes and PIVATs to track their progress. Experiences, successes and daily achievements will be shared through their annual reviews, parent's evenings and Seesaw.

Talking turns and sharing will be encouraged this half term as we all get to know each other and settle into our new class. We will be joining Whole school and key stage assemblies for Picture news.

This half term we will be learning about Islam through the question; How might beliefs about creation affect the way people treat the world? And Judaism with the question; Why might some people put their trust in God?

PE will be with our link class. (Wednesday & Fridays) We will also work hard to strengthen our hands and fingers for handwriting and letter formation through pre-write sessions and other fine motor tasks.
