Enrichment

At our staff meeting last week, all our teaching staff came together to discuss plans for enrichment for this year. There are some exciting opportunities in the works. Mrs Shorrocks has secured some funding which will allow us to pay for the majority of enrichment activities. We will still be asking for a small voluntary contribution of £10 per family to support this. In the week before half term, you will receive a letter specifically for your child's year group outlining the enrichment offer for the year and a breakdown of costings.

Attendance



Thank you to our families that have their children in school on time. Classes which have the highest punctuality will receive an extra playtime the following week! It is a legal requirement that children are in school by 8.55am. When a child is late, even if only by a few minutes this can cause considerable disruption, not just to their own learning, but to the learning of the rest of the class and impacts on the rewards your child's class can receive each week for 100% punctuality. Lost minutes EQUAL Lost Learning' just 5 minutes late each day equates to 3 days of school missed each year.
