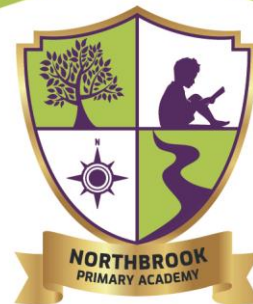


## Northbrook Primary Academy - Homework




**Class:** Year 1

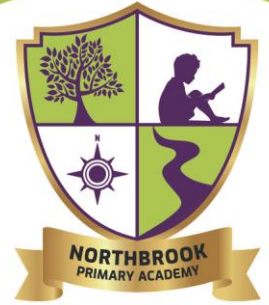
**Half-term:** Autumn 2 (Monday 28<sup>h</sup> October – Monday 9<sup>th</sup> December)

<p><b>Write a list (and check it twice)</b> Write a Christmas List to Father Christmas! Make sure you write 'Dear Father Christmas' and finish it with your name. You can either bring it into school to show me or post it in a post box –make sure Mums and Dads see them before you post them!</p>	<p><b>Reading Den</b> Build a reading den and read in it! Fill your den with lots of comfy cushions, blankets and teddies and read a story on your own or with a family member.</p>	<p><b>Answer the Question</b> Why do some people celebrate Bonfire night on the 5<sup>th</sup> November each year?</p>
<p><b>Reading Book</b> Read your school reading book with an adult. Draw a picture of your favourite part of the story and write a sentence.</p>	<p><b>Animal Fact Finding</b> Create a fact poster for an animal of your choice. Draw a picture of your animal and find facts in books or on the internet to go with it.</p>	<p><b>Happy Feet!</b> Use your own 'happy feet' to create a dance to your favourite song! Record it and upload to Seesaw!</p>
<p><b>Animals from Hot and Cold places</b> Research animals in hot and cold areas. Choose your favourite and create a 3D model of it!</p>	<p><b>Go on a Shape Hunt</b> What shapes can you find around your house? Create a tally chart or list of the shapes you can see. You could even have a look outside at what shapes you can find!</p>	<p><b>Let's get Physical!</b> Create an obstacle course in your house or garden and complete it with a family member. Who can complete your course the fastest?</p>
<p><b>Addition machine</b>  Can you create an addition machine to help you add two numbers together?</p>	<p><b>Bird Watch</b> Go to the local park or sit in your garden, how many birds can you spot? Do you know their names? Draw the birds you can see.</p>	<p><b>Children's Choice</b> Have your own homework idea linked to our topic or what we have been learning about. Extra points for creativity.</p>
