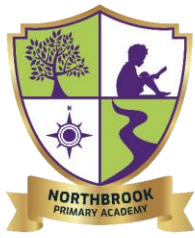


Maths:

This half term we will continue our work on multiplication and division. We will be multiplying and dividing bigger numbers and looking at the concept of remainders. We will also begin our work on fractions.

English: The text that we will look at this half term is 'The Stig of the Dump' by Clive King and explore will use this text explore character descriptions and create our own story. We will also be writing a non chronological report based on our history topic, the Ancient Egyptians.



RE: The question that we will be considering this half term is "Why are Gurus important to Sikhs?". We will explore Sikhism and look at how the ten Gurus shaped the religion.



Year 3 Half Term 5/Summer 1:

Science: This half term in science we will be continuing our work with magnets. We will then be moving onto the topic of light.



PE: Physical Education will be lead by our sport partners at West Lancashire Sports Partnership on a Thursday and by Mrs Wilson on a Tuesday. We will focus on Athletics and striking and fielding games.

Computing: In computing this half term we will be finishing our unit on email and then looking at branching databases which use yes and no questions to generate answers. We will even be having a go testing each pther.

History: In History we will be looking at the Ancient Egyptians and comparing Ancient Egypt the Bronze Age Britain. We will learn about why the river Nile was so important, what the pyramids were used for and all about who Tutankhamun was. We will also be going over to our friends at Woodlea for an Egyptian themed day!



Spanish: This half term the focus in Spanish will be food. The class will be supporting their learning of foods by reading and understanding the very hungry caterpillar story.



Music: The theme in music this half term will be “bringing us together” we will look at how music can help bring everyone together as a community. The style of music that we will be focusing on is Disco.

Year 3 Half Term 5/Summer 1: The Romans

Art & Design: In Art this half term we will be looking at the artistic mediums of mosaic and collage. We will explore the work of Gary Drostle and Antoni Gaudi and consider how different materials can be used to create artwork that tells a story.
