We are very excited to share with you your child's enrichment for the year ahead.

Your child's teachers have looked at the curriculum and where possible planned enrichment opportunities spread across the year. Your child will have the opportunity to experience a range of exciting and engaging activities. They have tried to be innovative and creative in bringing their learning to life and educationally beneficial.
