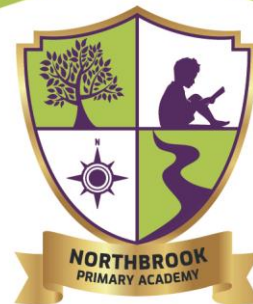

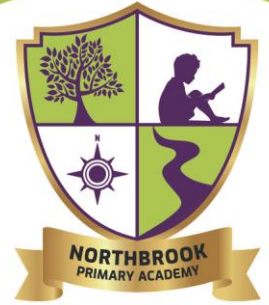
Half-term: Autumn 2 (Monday 28th October – Monday 16th December)

Describe what the firework looks like and what it does. Think about the colours, sounds and smells. Use adjectives, adverbs and similes.</p>	<p>Maths</p> <p>Practice the times tables that you are on. How quickly can you say them? What did you do to help you remember them?</p>
<p>Spanish</p> <p>Draw a picture using lots of colours. Label each colour that you use in Spanish.</p>	<p>Science</p> <p>Draw a diagram showing what happens in the water cycle.</p>	<p>English</p> <p>Write a poem about world war two.</p>
<p>Computing</p> <p>Make a poster the explain to a year 2 child how to keep themselves safe on the internet.</p>	<p>Design Technology</p> <p>Try some dips. Include dates, locations, which nations were involved and the outcome.</p>	<p>Children's choice</p> <p>Have your own homework idea linked to our topic or what we have been learning about. Extra points for creativity.</p>
