Year 6 Activity Week – Monday 24th June to Wednesday 26th June

Dear Parents/Carers,

As you know, next week we have planned an action-packed, multi-activity three-day celebration that will give the children opportunity to experience fun and challenging sessions with their friends and staff that have worked with them during their time at Northbrook Primary Academy. We have detailed the key information below so you are aware of the arrangements and the equipment they will need.

Monday 24th June – Visit to Tarleton Academy: Archery, Climbing Wall, Forest School Activities & Swimming

Venue: Tarleton Academy (<u>Tarleton Academy</u>)

Times: 8:45am - 4:00pm.

Clothing: Sports/suitable clothing and footwear for being active and getting dirty! Swimming shorts/costume and towel.

Additional info: Bring spare clothing and footwear in case the weather conditions require children to change into dry clothes. Children will need a packed lunch (those entitled will receive a packed lunch

from school).

Year 6 will be travelling by minibus from school to Tarleton Academy. They will be accompanied by Mr Cunniffe, Mrs Morris and Mrs Cole. They will leave at 9:00am and return to school for 4:00pm. They will be involved in a swimming session, a climbing wall activity, an archery session and a Forest School session on the Tarleton Academy site.

Tuesday 25th June – GamerX and School Hall Sleepover


Venue: Gamer X Preston (Gamer X Preston)

Times: 12:00pm-2:00pm. A coach will transport staff and children from school at 11:15am and will leave to return at 2:15pm. GamerX includes VR gaming, inflatables, arcade machines and lunch! **Clothing**: Suitable clothing for physical activity. For the 'Big Sleepover' children to attend at 7:00pm in suitable pyjamas. Duvet or sleeping bag and pillow, toiletries and a set of clothes for the next day are required too.

Year 6 will be travelling by coach to GamerX in Preston. They will be accompanied by Mrs Morris and Mr Mallon. They will leave at 11:15am and return to school for 3:00pm for the usual 3:15pm finish. They will then be invited back to school for the 'Big Sleepover' and pizza evening at 7:00pm. The children should return to school at 7:00pm in their pyjamas (suitable ones for modesty). They need to bring a sleeping bag or duvet and a pillow.

They also need to have clothes with them for the next day and toiletries — don't forget their tooth brush! The children will sleep in the school, after watching a film with pizza and snacks. Children are welcome to bring card games and boards games but no electronic devices. Mobile phones should be left at home. If you wish your child to have their mobile phone it must be handed to a member of staff on arrival at school. They will be kept securely and returned to the children the next day.

Staff will be on duty with them all night. There will be curfew for 'lights out'. We are sure there will not be an issue, however, if there are any behavioural issues, parents will be contacted to collect their child from school, even in the early hours!

In the morning, the children will wash and change into their fresh clothes. Breakfast will be provided, and the children will have a chilled morning before they leave to go bowling.

Wednesday 26th June – Bowling and Pizza

Venue: Level, Preston (<u>Preston's Largest Leisure Venue • Level (levelpreston.co.uk)</u>

Times: Leave by minibus at 9:15am

Clothing: Own clothes (non-uniform) and suitable for school trip and a bowling activity. Please ensure

suitable footwear is worn.

Additional information: Bring a small amount of money for the arcade machines if you wish!

We will leave school after a chilled morning at 9:15am and travel to Preston by minibus. The children will be accompanied by Mr Cunniffe and Mrs Cole. They will participate in 2 games of bowling and have lunch. Each lane accommodates 6 players. They will return to school about 1:00pm and will finish at the earlier time of 1:15pm. Parents will need to complete the ParentApp survey to give permission for their child to leave school or confirm collection of their child at this time (if we do not receive consent for the children to leave or be collected early, they will remain in school until the normal finish time of 3:15pm). On Thursday 27th June, all children transferring to Wellfield Academy in September, will need to attend for their first Transition Day at 9:15am in their Northbrook uniform. They will finish at Wellfield at 2:30pm. There will then be a Parental Meeting at Wellfield at 6:00pm.
