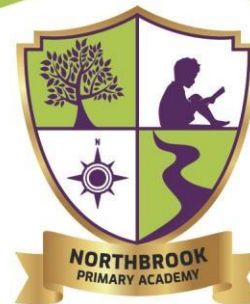

Which animal's year were you born in? What about your family?</p>
<p>Out of this World Draw a picture or make a model of all the planets in the solar system. Can you name them all?</p>	<p>Heaviest to Lightest Choose 5 objects from around your house. Without touching them, can you predict which will be the lightest? Can you predict which will be the heaviest? Now can you put them in order from the heaviest to the lightest? If you can, use scales to help you. The higher the number, the heavier the object!</p>	<p>Winter/Spring Go for a walk with your family and find evidence of Winter or Spring. You can either collect artefacts or take pictures of what you find!</p>
<p>Label it! What is your favourite thing to do in winter weather? Draw a picture of you in the winter and write some words to label it.</p>	<p>Pegs on a Box How many clothes pegs can you peg onto the side of a box in a minute? Using your thumb and pointy finger, peg each clothes peg onto the side of the box.</p>	<p>People Who Help Us Look at your community and see what people help you and how they help you. Can you choose someone in your community to draw a picture of? Write a sentence to say what they do to help us.</p>
