Year 5 have been testing water resistance and streamlined shapes this week, making their own designs and testing them out!


Year 4 have been learning all about World War II and the Blitz. As part of their learning, they have created beautiful pieces of artwork which are on display in their classroom.

Reception have been identifying parts of plants! Miss Cookson brought in various live plants for the children to cut and sort into categories dependent on their parts.



Important messages

Think Water! Very few school children drink enough water. School children need to drink at least 6-8 glasses of fluids (1.5-2 litres), ideally water, but also some milk, taken regularly throughout the day (at least 3-4 glasses while at school). Research has shown that not drinking enough water can lead to health problems and can also affect concentration, learning and behaviour.

It is very important that all our pupils at NPA bring water bottles containing **only** water for drinking during class. They can bring squash or fruit juice with their packed lunches but for lunchtimes only. Students opting for school lunches have a choice of water or milk at lunchtime. Sweet and acidic drinks (including those that are sugar-free) are harmful to teeth. Furthermore, the consumption of high-sugar soft drinks can cause a rapid rise in blood sugar levels, followed by a dip, resulting in low levels of physical and mental energy. Having only water in your child's water bottle also reduces the damaged caused by the accidental spills that occur each day in school – thank you for your co-operation!

Top Tip - Wash the bottles daily in warm soapy water, scrub the caps with a brush, rinse, and leave the bottles to air-dry upside down in a hygienic place; or wash them in a dishwasher if the bottles are suitable

Uniform update: We have worked hard this week to speak to students about the importance of our school uniform and to raise some excitement for our brand new uniform in September! We know that COVID, school closures and shops closures has had a significant impact on parent's ability to get new uniform items. However, we very much want students to be in full uniform and would like to support any family that may be having difficulty. We have spoken to our uniform supplier and they have reduced costs of the current uniform. For example, sweatshirts are currently selling for £3-£4, cardigan £3.50 and Northbrook Polo £2.50.
