Arrangements for the Final Few Days

After what was a fantastic Sports Day, during which the children demonstrated all the Northbrook Primary Academy values which lie at the heart of everything we do, we wanted to let you know about the arrangements for the final few days.

On Friday 16th July, after our weekly awards assembly we will be hosting a transition morning when all our children will move up to their new classroom with their new teacher. This will help them to develop a relationship with their new teacher ready for September as well as to get a feel for their new classroom surroundings. Year 6 children will need to attend school wearing their PE kit as they will get an additional PE session with Mr Cook during this time as well a special treat at lunchtime when they will enjoy a McDonalds with Mrs Spence.

Monday 19th July will be an 'Enrichment Day' when we will focus on enjoyment, being creative and being active. All the children can attend school in their own clothes on this day but must wear clothing that is suitable to be involved in a variety of physical activities, including trainers. If they wish they can wear their school PE kit. Our no jewellery and make-up policy will still apply to all children.

On this day Year 4, Year 5 and Year 6 will be travelling to Tarleton Academy by coach at approximately 9.30am. Whilst travelling by coach they will be seated in register order and grouped in their bubble. They will need to wear a face mask during the entirety of the journey unless of course they are medically exempt. After arriving at Tarleton Academy, they will be involved in a climbing session on an outdoor climbing wall, archery, forest schools and a sports session in the sports hall. The climbing, archery and forest school sessions will be run by qualified external coaches, supported by the staff from Northbrook Primary Academy. All children will need to bring a packed lunch for the day and a water bottle. Children entitled to free school meals will be issued a lunch before leaving school. The bus will return to school for the usual 3.15pm finish. It could be another warm day so please make sure you child has sun cream and a cap/hat.

Reception, Year 1, Year 2 and Year 3 will remain in school. During the day they will be involved with sessions on a bouncy castle, inflatable slide, arts and crafts and a sports session. Lunch will be as normal in the school dining room and all activities will finish for the usual 3.10pm/3.15pm finish.
