If your child is successful in gaining a place, you will be notified by text message and requested to pay for the club via ParentPay. Full payment must be received by 9.30am on Thursday 14th March.

Please note -

Children who qualify for Pupil Premium will be eligible for **one free club** per academic year, as their funding allocation will cover the cost of the club.
