

Dear Parents

I know you must have questions about your child moving to Grove in September, as by now we would usually have met your child and they would have spent time with us. However, the current circumstances have prevented our usual transition arrangements. I am delighted to say that your child is invited to visit Grove for 2 hours during the last week of this term (week beginning 13th July). You will soon receive a text with the date and time of your child's visit. Any children who are already in school at Hamilton or Northwood will remain in their current bubble for this visit, to keep them safe.

Please bring your child to the Keelings Road entrance on the day of their visit, and Grove staff will meet them and take them in. Parents will be given some forms to take home and complete.
