
Sculpture and 3D: Clay Houses

Sticky Knowledge facts:

- Sculpture is a 3D form of art.
- Wet clay makes a very useful building material because it hardens as it dries.
- Clay can be smoothed and tools can be pressed into it to make patterns.
- Clay can be shaped in ways such as rolling, flattening or squashing.
- A joining technique for clay is called score and slip.
- Rachel Whiteread uses a method called 'casting' by using a mold to create a sculpture.
