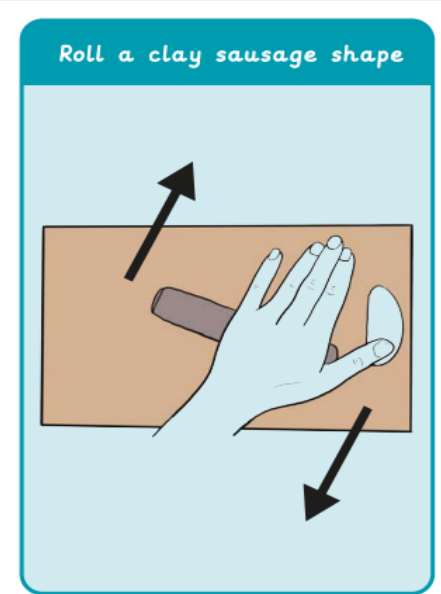
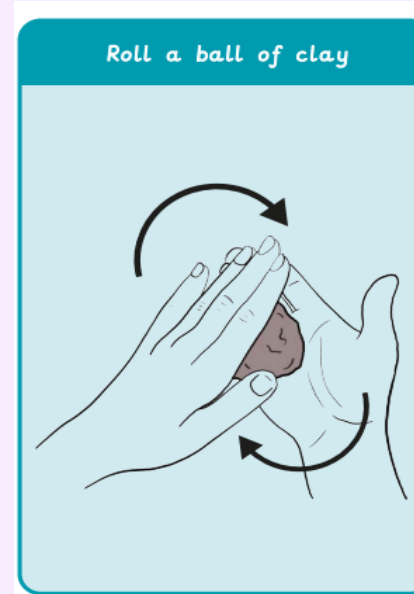


# Sculpture and 3D: Clay Houses

Key Vocabulary:	
<b>Impressing</b>	To make a mark or design on an object by using a stamp or seal.
<b>Relief</b>	Where the background is carved away, leaving the raised areas of clay to form a design.
<b>Score</b>	Scratching marks on the surface of clay in order to join two pieces.
<b>Slip</b>	Water and clay mixed together used to stick two pieces of clay.
<b>Ceramic</b>	A material made of clay and hardened by heat.



## Sticky Knowledge facts:

- ◆ Sculpture is a 3D form of art.
- ◆ Wet clay makes a very useful building material because it hardens as it dries.
- ◆ Clay can be smoothed and tools can be pressed into it to make patterns.
- ◆ Clay can be shaped in ways such as rolling, flattening or squashing.
- ◆ A joining technique for clay is called score and slip.
- ◆ Rachel Whiteread uses a method called 'casting' by using a mold to create a sculpture.
