

Structures: Baby Bear's Chair

Key Vocabulary:	
Fabric	A natural or man-made woven or knitted material that is made from plant fibres, animal fur or synthetic material.
Stencil	A shape that you can draw around.
Template	A stencil which you use to help you raw a shape more easily on to different materials.
Sew	To join or fasten by stitches made using a needle and thread.
Running Stitch	A simple style of sewing in a straight line with no overlapping.

Often **structures** have a certain **function**, they are made to do something. e.g. Chairs are for sitting on.



They should be **stable**, **strong** and comfortable. Was baby bear's chair **stable** and **strong**?



Sticky Knowledge facts:

- ◆ Often structure have a certain function, they are made to do something, eg, chairs are for sitting on.
- ◆ A design criterion is a list of points for the product to meet the needs.
- ◆ Stable structures are safer because they do not easily topple over or fall down.
- ◆ Evaluation is to look at the good and bad points about something to help us improve, and testing a product lets us find out if everything works as it should.
