Sculpture	A sculpture is a 3D (solid) piece of artwork.
Etching	A printing process created by scratching lines onto a plate, applying ink and then paper.
Land art	Art that is made directly into the ground using natural materials such as rocks and twigs.
Sketch	A rough first drawing which helps you to plan your work.
Metallic	A metal colour.

Sticky Knowledge facts:
