Early Years Foundation Stage Objectives

16-26 months

1. Plays alongside others.





2. Uses a familiar adult as a secure base from which to explore independently in new environments, e.g. ventures away to play and interact with others, but returns for a cuddle or reassurance if becomes anxious.

3. Plays cooperatively with a familiar adult, e.g. rolling a ball back and forth.

22-36 months

- 1. Interested in others' play and starting to join in.
- 2. Seeks out others to share experiences.
- 3. Shows affection and concern for people who are special to them.
- 4. May form a special friendship with another child.

30-50 months

- 1. Can play in a group, extending and elaborating play ideas, e.g. building up a role-play activity with other children.
- 2. Initiates play, offering cues to peers to join them.
- 3. Keeps play going by responding to what others are saying or doing.
- 4. Demonstrates friendly behaviour, initiating conversations and forming good relationships with peers and familiar adults

40-60 months

- 1. Initiates conversations, attends to and takes account of what others say.
- 2. Explains own knowledge and understanding, and asks appropriate questions of others.
- 3. Takes steps to resolve conflicts with other children, e.g. finding a compromise.

ELG

- 1. Children play co-operatively, taking turns with others.
- 2. They take account of one another's ideas about how to organise their activity.
- 3. They show sensitivity to others' needs and feelings, and form positive relationships with adults and other children.
