Dear Parents / Carers

Stoke-on-Trent City Council recognises that life is harder for families facing increased pressure on household budgets due to COVID-19. This winter the Council has received grant funding from the Government Department of Work and Pensions to provide support to families with children, other vulnerable households and individuals from early December 2020 until the end of March 2021.

As part of this programme of support the Council are providing vouchers for families of children attending schools and academies in the city who have free school meals, families with children who have an Education and Health Care Plan in place or families who have been identified as requiring this support.

Each eligible child in the family will receive a voucher for £35 for the Christmas break.

If you are eligible, before the end of term, you will receive a link directly from Schoolvouchers.com and you will be able to select an eVoucher from a supermarket on the list. You will be able choose from Aldi, Asda, Iceland, Morrisons, Sainsburys, Tesco and Waitrose. The eVoucher code will be displayed on-screen and can be downloaded.

If you do not have access to a phone or email, our academy will be able to download your eVoucher and provide you with a printed copy. You can find more information about downloading the vouchers online in the parent FAQs here: <https://help.schoolvouchers.com/hc/en-gb>
