Science

The children will be learning all about animals, their habitats and we will be matching animals to their offspring. We will explore the textures of the skin and fur of these animals by using toy animals and researching what this looks and feels like. In line with planting last term, the children will observe the seeds we planted and use simple descriptive language of the changes they have noticed in the banana plant we have in the class. They will record their findings of the changes by measuring and drawing what they see.

History

In term 6, the children will be learning about The Ancient Egyptians. They will compare past and present by describing objects and artefacts from these eras. The children will be making a 3D pyramid, designing a Pharaoh's crown, and decoding hieroglyphics in addition to creating a Mummy as a class where they will investigate the stages of mummification. These activities offer handson learning and introduce basic concepts of ancient Egyptian culture.

Literacy

The children will continue to look at language comprehension, word reading, and writing skills. They will enjoy sharing stories, songs and rhymes and discuss key events in stories. They will continue to use their word mats to support them when writing and be encouraged to do this independently. Read, Write, Inc. will continue to be delivered in groups daily to ensure children's knowledge around sounds, blending and reading aloud continues to grow. The children will read daily with adults and be encouraged to share the stories they have chosen with the class

Maths

In term 6, the children will be gap filling and building on their pre-taught knowledge to ensure their learning is embedded. They will look at measure by using rulers, they will make matches and compare sizes, and stations will be set up around the classroom where children can measure and record their findings.

Art

The children will be introduced to basic tools and simple stitches through hands-on projects. These activities will support the children to develop their fine motor skills, hand and eye-coordination and concentration on a task. The children will begin to identify and use different forms of textiles and fabrics

RE
