
Dear Parents/Carers,

This week's recommended read is from Y6 librarian Isabelle Bramley

'Skandar and the Unicorn Thief'

By A.F.Steadman



A.F. Steadman's first fantasy novel is a thrilling story set at an intriguing island school called the Eyrie. It follows Skandar Smith's journey from ordinary teenage boy to fierce unicorn rider.

This enthralling adventure contains elemental magic, sky battles, ancient secrets and ferocious unicorns.



The Queen's Reading Room is a Charity working to Celebrate and promote the power and benefits of reading.

The project has revitalised library spaces in 50 primary schools so far. We will be applying for help to further strengthen our library areas. Queen Camilla believes that reading will open doors for children and make a 'huge difference' to their lives, "the more books you read, the more you're going to learn".

Recent research undertaken by the Charity has found that reading for just 5 minutes per day reduced stress by 20%. The study also found that high-frequency fiction readers found it easier to read a map, find a new place and follow a newspaper story—skills for life!

Thanks to **Drake The Bookshop**, our two Y6 classes were lucky to meet **Skandar author A F Steadman**. The Skandar series is described as HEROES AND UNICORNS AS YOU'VE NEVER SEEN THEM BEFORE.

It is an **award-winning**, international hit fantasy adventure series for children age 9+, and also for fans of Harry Potter, Percy Jackson, Eragon and Fireborn.

Annabel's latest book was released just last week so the Y6s were amongst the first to be given a sneak **preview** into the fabulous world of the Island and the latest secrets from the Eyrie about Skandar, Kenna and his friends. Children were able to buy signed copies and we also purchased some for our **Hogwarts school library**.

Annabel is an inspirational **speaker** and the books are widely seen as the biggest thing since Harry Potter hit the shelves!
