### Autumn term 2025

The Autumn term runs from: Monday 1 September to Friday 19 December 2025. Monday 1 September is a PD day so <u>children will return to school on Tuesday 2 September 2025</u>. There is also a PD day on Friday 26 September 2025.

Half-term holiday runs from: Monday 27 October to Friday 31 October 2025 inclusive. The children will break up on Friday 24 October. The children will return to school on Monday 3 November 2025.

Christmas holidays run from: Monday 22 December 2024 to Friday 2 January 2026 inclusive. The children break up on Friday 19 December 2025.

#### Spring term 2025

The Spring term runs from: Monday 5 January to Thursday 2 April 2026. The children will return to school on Monday 5 January 2026. There is a PD day on Friday 30 January.

Half-term holiday runs from: Monday 23 February to Friday 27 February 2026 inclusive. The children will break up on Friday 20 February and will return to school on Monday 2 March 2026.

Easter holidays run from: Friday 3 April to Friday 17 April 2026 inclusive. The children will break up on Thursday 2 April and will return to school on Monday 20 April 2026.

#### Summer term 2025

The Summer term runs from: Monday 20 April to Monday 27 July 2026.

Bank holiday (school closed): Monday 4 May 2026

Half-term holiday runs from: Monday 25 May to Friday 5 June 2026 inclusive (two weeks). The children will break up on Friday 22 May and will return to school on Monday 8 June 2026.

The children's last day at school before the summer holidays will be Tuesday 27 July 2026. In September, we will continue to ask that in Years 1-6 children come to school in their **PE kit** on their **PE day/s**.

This will mean that:

- Time isn't wasted with children getting changed!
- Clothes won't get lost!
- Children don't need to worry about privacy or be self-conscious getting changed
- Everyone will have PE kit, hair tied back and earrings removed on their PE day!

The **PE uniform** is displayed on our **school website** for children. Although you do not need to purchase Oakdene branded uniform, please ensure that you **wear the school colours.** Plain dark green or black joggers can be worn during colder months, then we recommend substituting joggers for plain green or black shorts in the warmer months.

If you would like to opt for the Oakdene branded uniform, but would like to save costs - Caswell's will embroider any supermarket / plain items of the full school uniform / PE kit.

They look very professional and are an alternative to buying branded uniforms from uniform shops.
