Y2 enjoyed a lovely day exploring the wildlife highlighted in the bestselling book 'The Lost Words' when they visited Danby Education Centre.

Children hunted for the lost words in **Crow Wood** and made a collective acrostic poem.

They were led on a gorgeous 1km **story walk** through woods and fields down to a small stream.

Through the **story**, the children discovered some of the 'lost' creatures and took part in **minibeast hunts** and games, whilst making **weasel homes** and **natural artwork**.









Each year, 8th May marks the anniversary of VE Day, the end of the Second World War in Europe.

The Y5 team recreated the nationwide celebrations of 1945 in school. The Y5s looked stunning in their authentic costumes, they sampled food from a typical rationed meal, played games and sang some wartime tunes!

This event marked a fitting end to the children's WW2 topic.



Y3s visited **Captain Cook's Museum** to follow in the footsteps of the young **James Cook.** They discovered a world of knowledge, enjoyment and inspiration!

They found out about Cook's Yorkshire background, his naval career, the great voyages of exploration and his ideas on topics such as diet and scurvy, and encounters with previously unknown peoples. We received a lovely email to share that:- "The Y3s were very well behaved all day (especially given the heat!) and very knowledgeable.

The learning facilitators were especially **impressed** with their knowledge on **Aboriginal Australian** culture! "









Y6 pupils visited the Hancock Museum to close their history topic 'Ancient Egyptians' to life.

The Egyptian gallery is really special – not only because of the large number of perfectly preserved artefacts it contains, but for the huge variety of objects on display.

The Y6s marvelled at enormous stone statues, tiny lucky charms, precious burial goods and entire coffins.









Oakdene entered one final football tournament for our Y6 boys. We travelled to The Glebe Primary in Norton, to compete against 9 other teams. We started off tremendously, as all children demonstrated their skill and fantastic team work to come out victorious in many of the matches.

We only conceded 5 goals throughout the whole tournament, as our defence stood strong. We won 8 out of 9 games! This impressive result meant we came joint winners at the top of the table with 24 points.

In September, we will continue to ask that in Years 1-6 children come to school in their **PE kit** on their **PE day/s**.
