Arrangements for considering complaints about SEND provision within school are stated in the SEND policy.

Initially, complaints should be discussed with the class teacher. Depending on the outcome of this meeting the SENCO (Mrs Farnaby) or the Head of School (Miss Champion) should be informed and a further meeting can be arranged. If parent(s)/carer(s) feel that the issue has not been resolved the complaints policy will be followed.
