








What does this map depict?




Biomes: A very large Ecosystem



Biome:

A large naturally occurring community of flora and fauna occupying a major habitat, e.g. forest, tundra, alpine

Assess this Biome's conditions, Why is it so cold at night?


Desert Biome

Because of the lack of water, deserts cannot support much vegetation. ... so during the night when the sun is not shining the sand loses all its heat, making the desert night cold. Sand is the biggest reason why deserts are hot during the day and cold during the night.


Extreme temps 43.5 to -38.5 degrees




