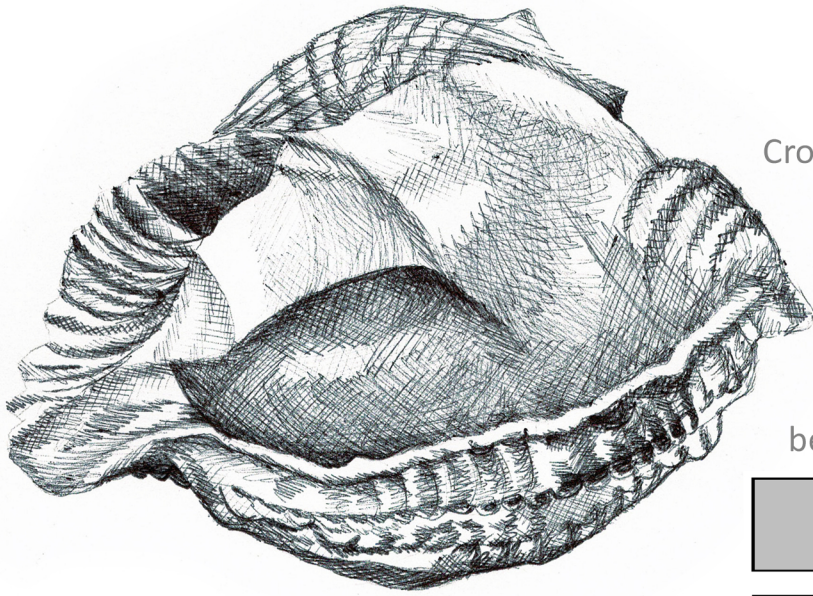
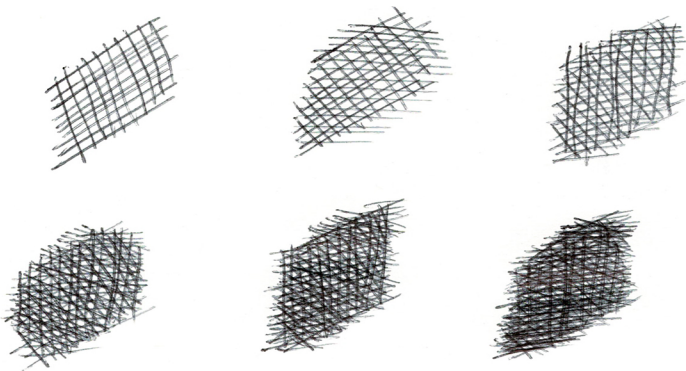


Cross Hatching With Pen



Cross hatching in art is a method of creating tone using intersecting sets of parallel lines. The more layers of parallel lines that you add, the darker the tone becomes. See if you can use cross hatching to create the different tones below in the empty rectangles.



Draw, using cross hatching and a pen, the shell above in the empty rectangle. You can lightly sketch in pencil first to get an accurate shape. Build up layers of hatching to reflect the different tones you can see. Try to include lights, mediums and darks. You will need to leave the page blank in the small areas where you want it to be white.
