

## Still III S

Stippling is the art of creating a picture or pattern using numerous, tiny, dots.



Look at the barnacles drawing to the left. It has been created using lots of tiny dots. Parts of the picture are darker where the dots are closer together.

Practise creating different tones in the small rectangles below. Try to match your tones to the tones you can see in the squares.



You are now going to create your own stippling drawing of the barnacles below. First, in pencil, create a line drawing of the barnacles. Work lightly so you can adjust your drawing if you need to. When you are happy with the drawing, use a pen to create a stippled artwork. When you have finished stippling in pen, you will be rubbing out all of your pencil lines.
