

Ideas for art work to do at home




TASK 1 - . You must draw them bigger than actual size.

HINTS - Look carefully at how each key is cut differently. Try to plan your drawing lightly at first and then press a little harder when you are happy with your composition. Use tone to create form.




TASK 2 - Copy your mobile phone. Look carefully at the shape and keys.

HINTS - You may want to add another object to help with scale. Try to plan your drawing lightly at first and then press a little harder when you are happy with your composition. Use tone to create form.



TASK 3 - A drawing of a hand in an interesting position.

HINTS - Look carefully at creases and folds in the skin. You could hold an interesting object. Try to plan your drawing lightly at first and then press a little harder when you are happy with your composition. Use tone to create form.




TASK 4 - A drawing of a cup or mug showing correct ellipses.

HINTS - An ellipse has no sharp corners. Draw any pattern on the cup and show how it looks as it disappears round the edge. Try to plan your drawing lightly at first and then press a little harder when you are happy with your composition. Use tone to create form.






TASK 5 - A drawing of a full length figure in correct proportion either from a drawing, photograph or real life.

HINTS - Avoid cartoon characters which often exaggerate proportion.




TASK 6 - A drawing of a watch or a clock.


HINTS - If drawing a watch make it much bigger than actual size. Try to plan your drawing lightly at first and then press a little harder when you are happy with your composition. Use tone to create form.





TASK 8- Fill a page of your sketchbook with features of the human face i.e. eyes / lips / noses / eyebrows. Include both drawings and collections from coloured magazines. Experiment with a variety of drawing materials e.g. graphite pencil, coloured pencils and soluble coloured pencils.



TASK 7- Draw members of your family / friends. Ask them to pose for you. Make sure you that you fill one page in your sketchbook. Try to plan your drawing lightly at first and then press a little harder when you are happy with your composition. Use tone to create form.







TASK 15- Research the work of David Hockney. Use a camera to produce your own joiner portrait. Display your joiner on carefully paper.








