

# Yr 8 visit Chessington World of Adventures

Dear Parents,

To celebrate the completion of your child's experience of Oakfield Academy we have arranged a trip to Chessington World of Adventures on Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> July 2025. This trip has been an Oakfield tradition for many years now, always providing lots of happy memories.

- 9.40am Pupils arrive and register in the Hall. Pupils **must** be provided with a packed lunch, plenty to drink, sunhats and cream, suitable footwear (trainers), shoulders and stomachs covered. If your child normally receives a free school meal, kindly confirm on Parentpay if you would like us to provide a packed lunch. **WRISTBANDS PROVIDED MUST BE WORN ALL DAY.**
- 8.00am Coaches depart.
- 10.25am Arrival at Chessington.
- 7.30pm Pupils return to Oakfield Academy. Kindly ensure that pupils are met promptly by a parent/designated member of the family.

The cost of this trip is £48.00 which includes the cost of the coach and entrance tickets.

Staged payment details as follows:-

**By the end of May £25.00 deposit – non refundable**  
**By 15<sup>th</sup> June £23.00 balance**

If you would like your child to join us, payment should be made via Parentpay. Please choose 'pay for other items' and **CHESSINGTON** will take you to the appropriate section. We hope that as many pupils as possible are able to join us for this fantastic day out!

Once inside the Park we will move to our central meeting point. Pupils will then be allowed to go off in small groups (minimum of three) to choose what they would like to do. Pupils will be expected to check-in at directed times twice during the day. All pupils will be issued with a wristband containing the academy's contact details. This must be worn at all times during the day. We do not recommend that pupils bring phones as there are no available lockers and we cannot take responsibility for them.

*We would like to take this opportunity to remind pupils and parents that behaviour must meet the expectations as outlined on pages 5 & 6, 15 & 16 in the journal. Failure to follow instructions or behave appropriately in a public space will result in removal from the trip and parents will be required to collect their child. If we deem behaviour as unacceptable prior to the trip and feel that your child might pose a risk to the successful management of the trip, your child will be advised that they are no longer able to attend.*
