COVID Vaccinations for 12 to 15 Year olds:

The Health and Social Care Secretary announced on Monday 29 November that young people aged 12 to 15 in England will be offered a second dose of the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine, following advice from JCVI. Parents of children aged 12-15 that have not yet had their first vaccine can book their child's first vaccination slot over the winter break via the national booking system. In some cases, parents will be able to get their booster at the same time as their child getting their first vaccine.

COVID vaccination walk-in clinics are being held on Tuesday 4th January, 09:30am - 12:00pm at Frome Town Hall, Christchurch Street West, Frome, Somerset BA11 1EB. These sessions are open to all 12 - 15 year olds who have not yet received their 1st dose.

Flu Vaccinations:

There will be a drop-in clinic for school aged children who have missed their FLU vaccination in school on Monday 20th December, 10am – 2pm, Cheese & Grain, Market Yd, Justice Lane, Frome BA11 1BE.

Asymptomatic Screening Tests on Site:

On Wednesday 5th January, we will be screening all Year 7 & 8 pupils as they return after the Christmas break. Those taking the test will be supervised by trained staff. The lateral flow tests are quick and easy to undertake, using a swab of the nose. Results (which take around 20 minutes from testing) will be shared directly with parents. Through a notification of a positive or negative result from the online NHS system.
